

22 communities and two towns were attacked by up to 3,000 Palestinian terrorists

In at least a dozen of the communities, most of which are agricultural villages (kibbutzim), homes and infrastructure were destroyed. All Israeli civilians that survived have now been evacuated from the area around the Gaza Strip, and many who survived the attack have nowhere left to return. This is the first time in Israel's 75-year history there are internally displaced citizens. Estimates say the number is higher than 50,000 people. 1400 Israelis dead – 210 hostages (w/30 children) 32 Americans killed, 10 Americans unaccounted for

IDF and Hezbollah fighters trade fire on Lebanese border – northern towns evacuated

7000 rockets fired into Israel (Hamas & Hezbollah) – about 10% from Gaza falling back into Gaza killing Gaza civilians

The Hamas-run Gaza health ministry claims at least 5,600 Palestinians overall have been killed in Gaza so far

Egyptian President Abdel Fattah el-Sisi has doubled down on his government's rejection of Palestinian refugees from Gaza the Egyptian leader set out a roadmap to end the ongoing war which included ensuring the flow of aid to Gaza, negotiating a cease-fire, and embarking on peace talks between Israel and the Palestinians to establish a Palestinian state based on the borders before the 1967 Mideast war.
