

The new study examined changes made to more than 80 textbooks from the 2022-23 Saudi curriculum and more than 180 textbooks from previous curricula.

The new study found “almost all examples portraying Christians and Jews in a negative manner” were removed from the latest textbooks. Textbooks from previous years referred to Jews as “monkeys and pigs who worship the devil”, describing them as “traitors by nature and sworn enemies of Islam”. The textbooks also reported that “Zionists use women, drugs and the media in order to achieve their goals” and “Israel has plans to expand its borders from the Nile River in Egypt to the Euphrates in Iraq”.

The study reported that phrases such as “Jews and Christians are the enemies of Islam,” or “Jews and Christians are criticized for having ‘destroyed and distorted’ the Torah and Gospel” were notably absent from the more recent schoolbooks.

[Saudi] textbooks are distributed to Muslim communities around the world and are studied by tens of millions of students in mosques and other educational settings.

As part of a push to "sinicize" religion, the Chinese Communist Party has embarked on a 10-year project to rewrite the Bible and other religious texts.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus famously confronts the accusers of a woman caught committing adultery, saying "let the one among you who is guiltless be the first to throw a stone at her."

The chastened accusers slink away and Jesus says to the woman, "'Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she replied. 'Neither do I condemn you,' said Jesus. 'Go away, and from this moment sin no more.'"

A beautiful story of forgiveness and mercy.

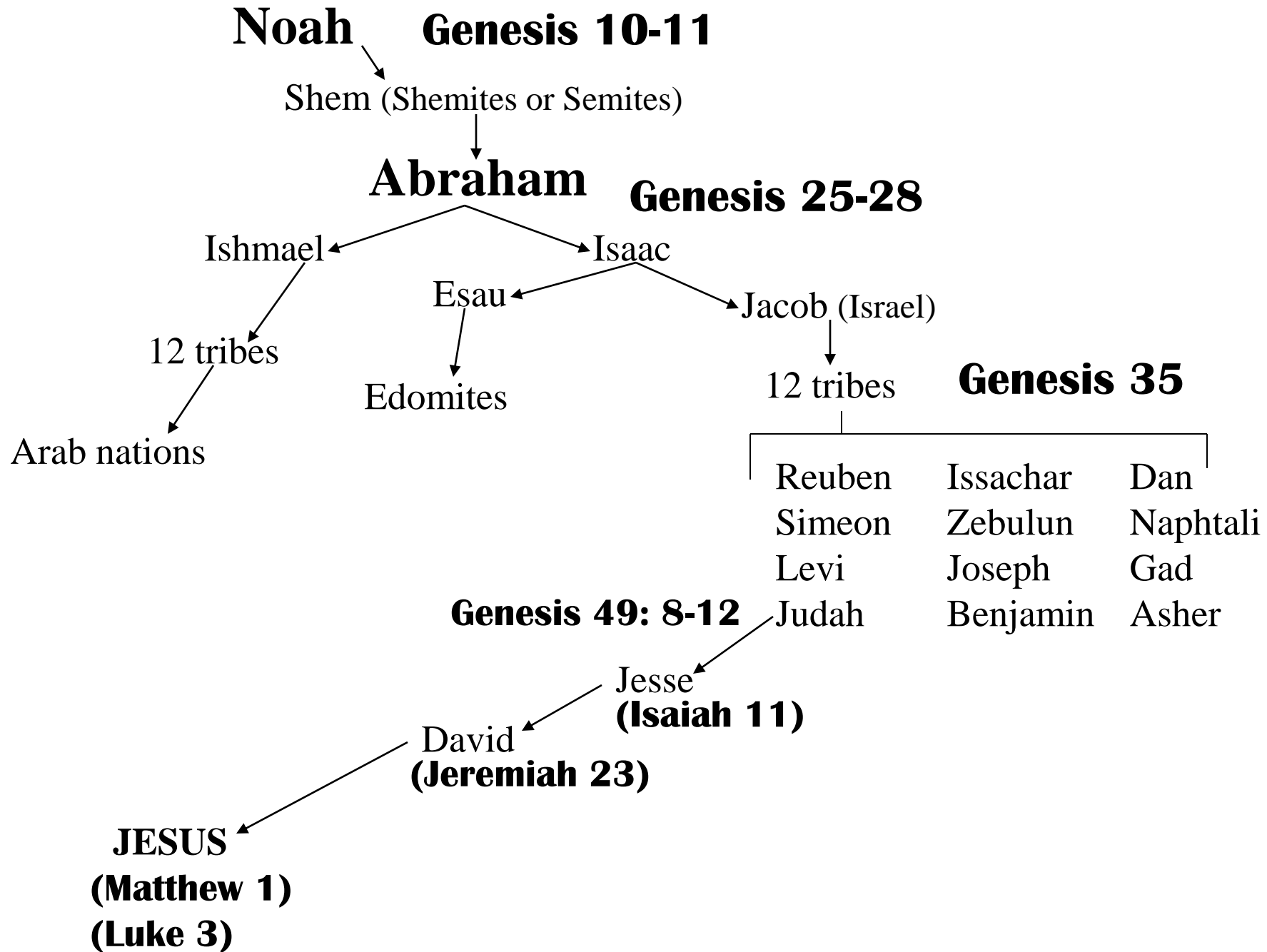

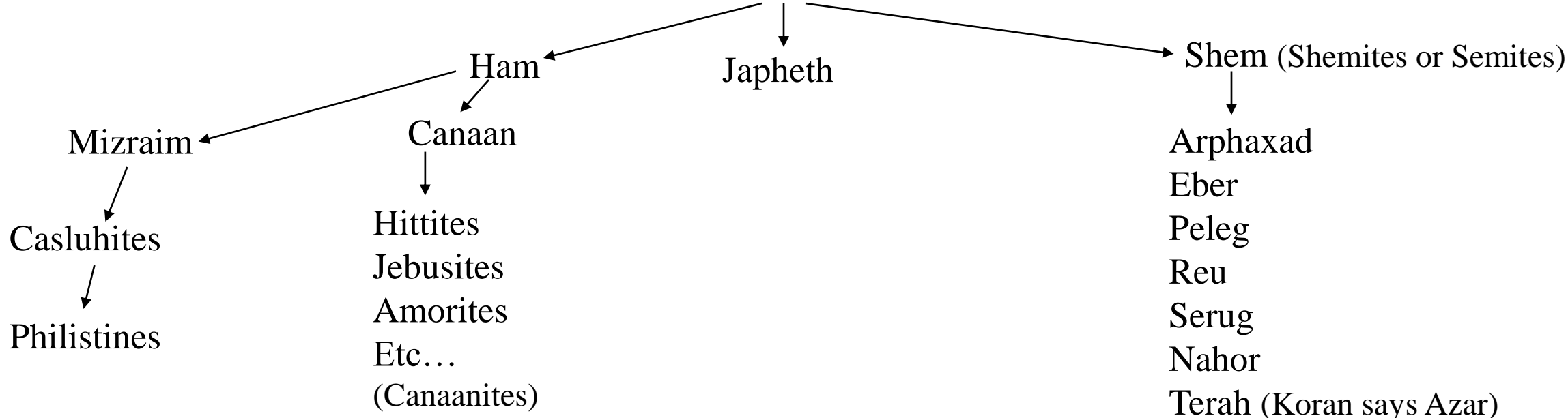
Palestinian Schoolbooks – 6/02

Tribal Distribution of Promised Land Numbers 34

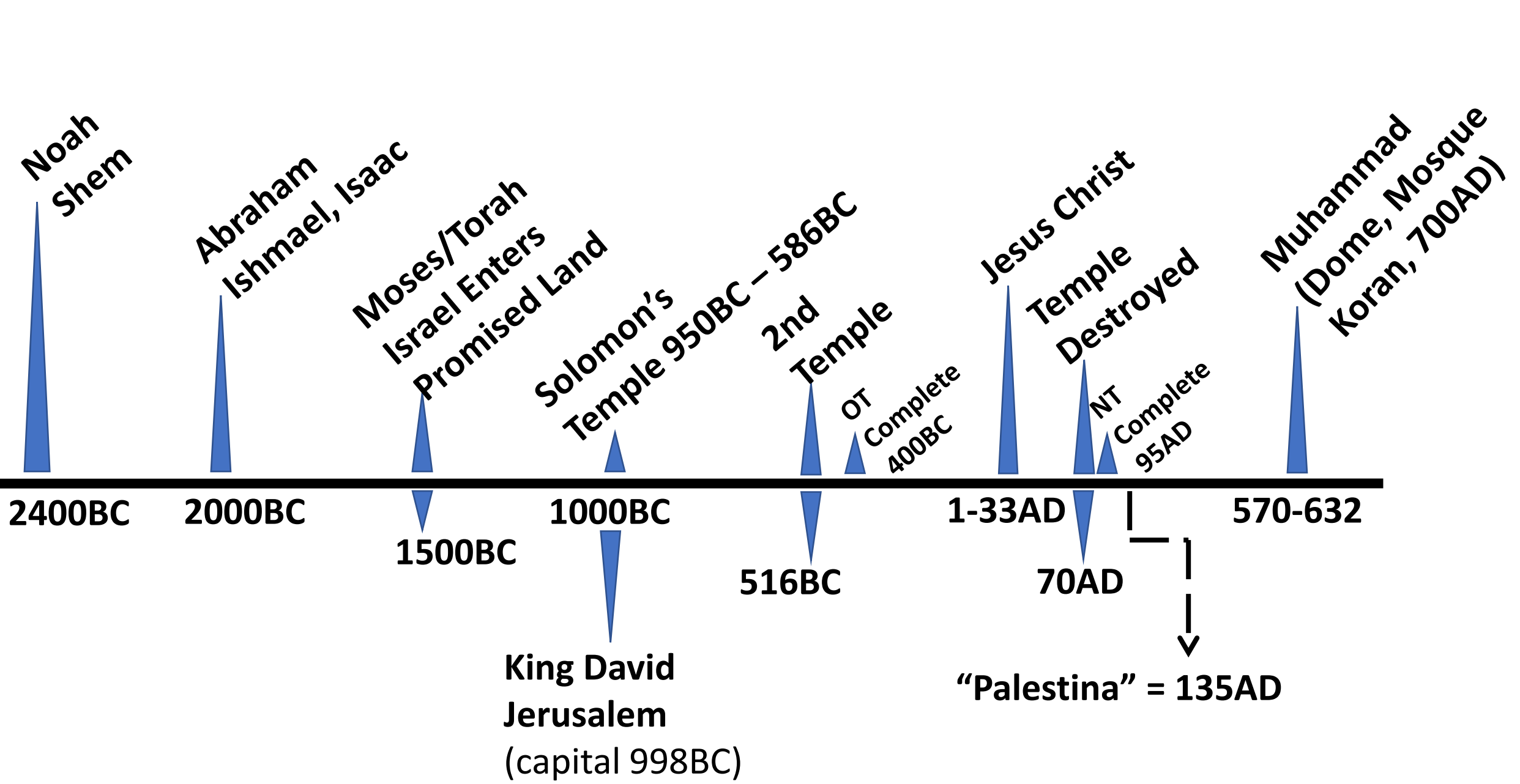

Since 1440BC the land of Israel has NEVER been devoid of a Jewish presence

Leaders of several Palestinian factions, including Hamas and the ruling Fatah faction, are scheduled to hold a one-day conference in the Egyptian capital of Cairo on Sunday at the invitation of Palestinian Authority President [Mahmoud Abbas](#) (who also heads Fatah).

At the conference, the Palestinian leaders will discuss ways of achieving national unity and the latest developments in the Palestinian arena.

Abbas is also hoping to persuade Hamas to join a new Palestinian unity government that would end the split between the West Bank and Gaza Strip. Last week, Abbas met in Ankara, Turkey, with Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh and discussed with him ways of achieving “national reconciliation” between Fatah and Hamas.

A similar meeting of the faction leaders held in 2020 via video conference failed to end the differences between the groups. Then, representatives of 14 factions in Ramallah and the Lebanese capital of Beirut participated in the conference, which ended with a joint communique strongly denouncing the Israeli government and the US administration. The communique also affirmed the Palestinian people’s “right to practice all forms of legitimate struggle [against Israel] and activate the comprehensive popular resistance as the appropriate option for this phase.”
