## LEVITICUS 25

Goel: to redeem (according to the Oriental law of kinship),  
i.e. to be the next of kin  
(and as such to buy back a relative's property, marry his widow, etc.):

# MY GOEL - MY REDEEMER

I am the Lord, and I will *bring you out* from under the yoke of the Egyptians.  
I will *free you* from being slaves to them, and I will *redeem you* with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment. I will *take you* as my own people, and I *will be* your God. Then you will know that I am the Lord your God, who *brought you out* from under the yoke of the Egyptians.  
And I will *bring you to* the land I swore with uplifted hand to give to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob.  
I will *give it to you* as a possession. I am the Lord.

**EXODUS 6:1-8**



# MY GOEL - MY REDEEMER

## LAND

Throughout the country that you hold as a possession, you must provide for the redemption of the land.

"If one of your countrymen becomes poor and sells some of his property, his nearest relative is to come and redeem what his countryman has sold.

## SLAVERY

'If an alien or a temporary resident among you becomes rich and one of your countrymen becomes poor and sells himself to the alien living among you or to a member of the alien's clan, he retains the right of redemption after he has sold himself.

One of his relatives may redeem him: An uncle or a cousin or any blood relative in his clan may redeem him.

## LAND

## SLAVERY

# MY GOEL - MY REDEEMER

Now Naomi had a relative on her husband's side, from the clan of Elimelech, a man of standing, whose name was Boaz

That man is our close relative; he is one of our kinsman-redeemers

Today you are witnesses that I have bought from Naomi all the property of Elimelech, Kilion and Mahlon. I have also acquired Ruth the Moabitess, Mahlon's widow, as my wife, in order to maintain the name of the dead with his property, so that his name will not disappear from among his family or from the town records

# MY GOEL - MY REDEEMER

"How great you are, O Sovereign Lord! There is no one like you, and there is no God but you, as we have heard with our own ears. And who is like your people Israel — the one nation on earth that God went out to **redeem as a people** for himself, and to make a name for himself, and to perform great and awesome wonders by driving out nations and their gods from before your people, whom you **redeemed from Egypt?** You have established your people Israel as your very own forever, and you, O Lord, have become their God."

Redeem Israel, O God,

Yet if there is an angel on his side  
as a **mediator**, one out of a thousand,  
to tell a man what is right for him,  
to be gracious to him and say,  
'Spare him from going down to the pit;  
I have found a **ransom** for him'—

# MY GOEL - MY REDEEMER

This is what the LORD says –  
your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel

**ISAIAH**
