One buried – one carried by angels

Abraham's bosom

ISAIAH 40:11

JOHN 13:21-25

MATTHEW 8:11

In Paradisum (Faure')

May the angels lead you into paradise;
May the martyrs receive you at your arrival,

And with Lazarus, once poor,
May you have eternal rest.

Sheol – the pit, the grave, the abyss

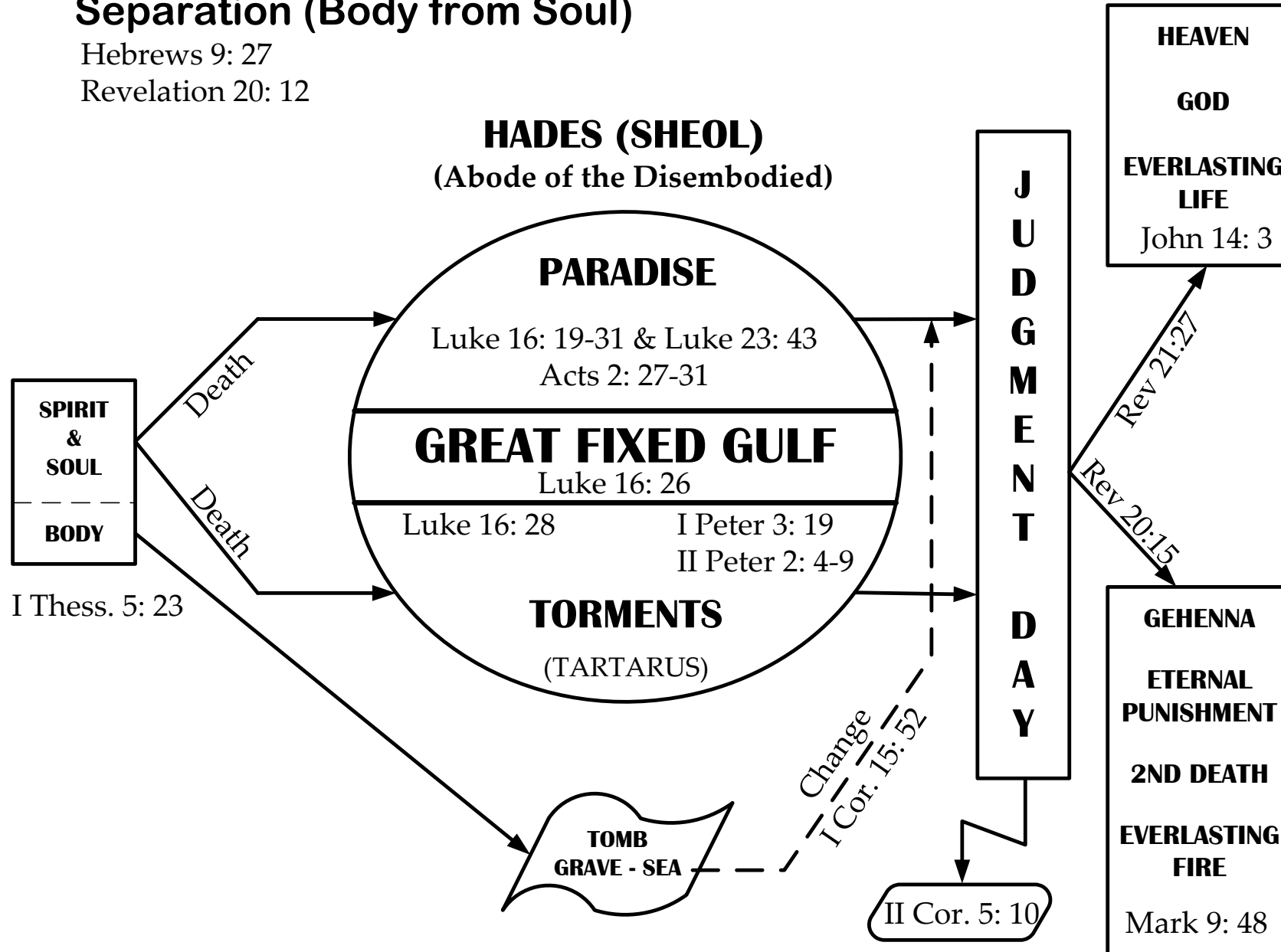

Sheol – the pit, the grave, the abyss

Hell - Always burning, never consuming – constant torment

LUKE 16: 23

he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off,
and Lazarus in his bosom.

Father Abraham, have mercy on me and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

ROCK A MY SOUL

LUKE 16: 24-25

Son, remember...

Not only NOT a drop of water,
but there is this great, fixed, un-crossable chasm

ROCK A MY SOUL

LUKE 16: 26

- No hell
- Punished, but not forever
- Hell, but *maybe* not eternal, then heaven...?

"Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."

Matthew 25: 46

Father Abraham, send Lazarus to my brothers!

ROCK A MY SOUL

LUKE 16: 27-28

Who, in our own lives,
do we need to keep from the place of torment?

They have Moses and the prophets!

ROCK A MY SOUL

LUKE 16: 29

The Hebrew Scriptures were sufficient for salvation

“Your accuser is Moses, on whom your hopes are set.

If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me.” John 5:45-47

No, BUT...

LUKE 16: 30

Heavy sigh – so, you want *another* sign?

“Why does this generation ask for a miraculous sign?”

Mark 8:11-12

**They're not going to get it,
even if someone rises from the dead!**

"This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead

Luke 24:25-48

Even with Scripture & a resurrection, still...
