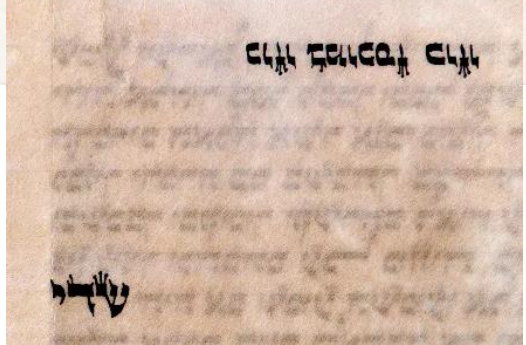

Chicago Statement on Biblical Inerrancy - 1978

1. God, who is Himself Truth and speaks truth only, has inspired Holy Scripture in order thereby to reveal Himself to lost mankind through Jesus Christ as Creator and Lord, Redeemer and Judge. Holy Scripture is God's witness to Himself.

2. Holy Scripture, being God's own Word, written by men prepared and superintended by His Spirit, is of infallible divine authority in all matters upon which it touches:
it is to be believed, as God's instruction, in all that it affirms:
obeyed, as God's command, in all that it requires; embraced, as God's pledge, in all that it promises.

3. The Holy Spirit, Scripture's divine Author, both authenticates it to us by His inward witness and opens our minds to understand its meaning.

4. Being wholly and verbally God-given, Scripture is without error or fault in all its teaching, no less in what it states about God's acts in creation, about the events of world history, and about its own literary origins under God, than in its witness to God's saving grace in individual lives.

5. The authority of Scripture is inescapably impaired if this total divine inerrancy is in any way limited or disregarded, or made relative to a view of truth contrary to the Bible's own; and such lapses bring serious loss to both the individual and the Church.

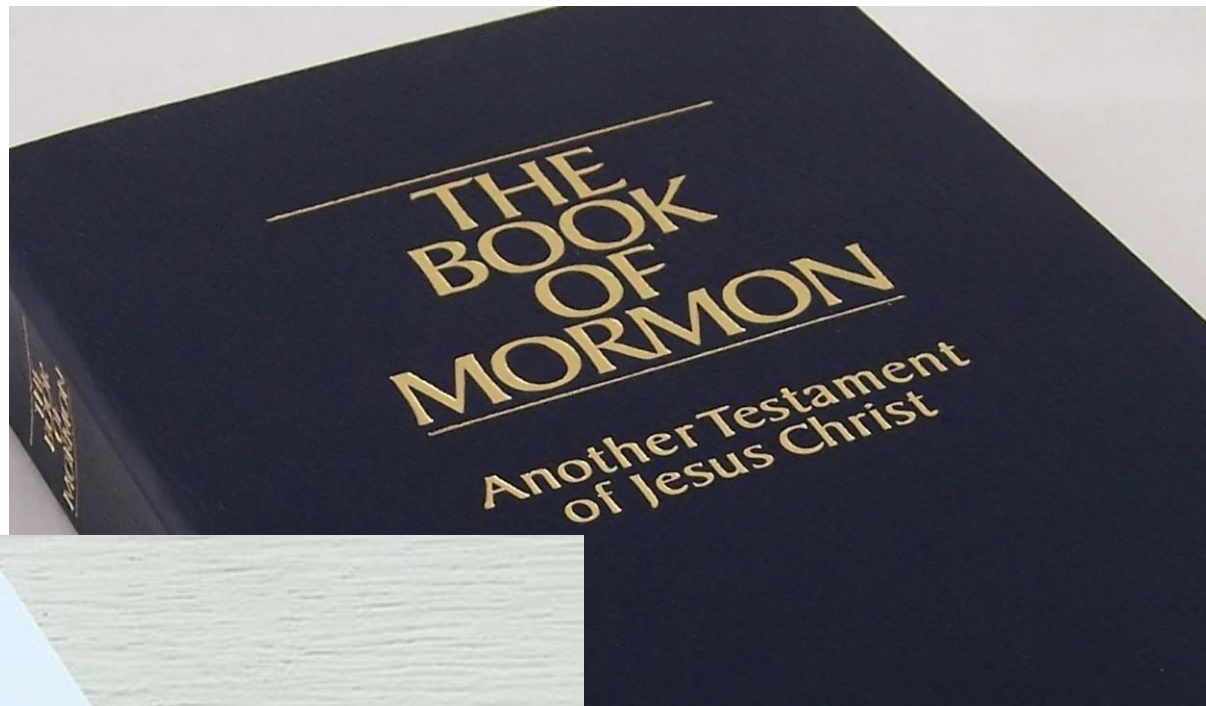
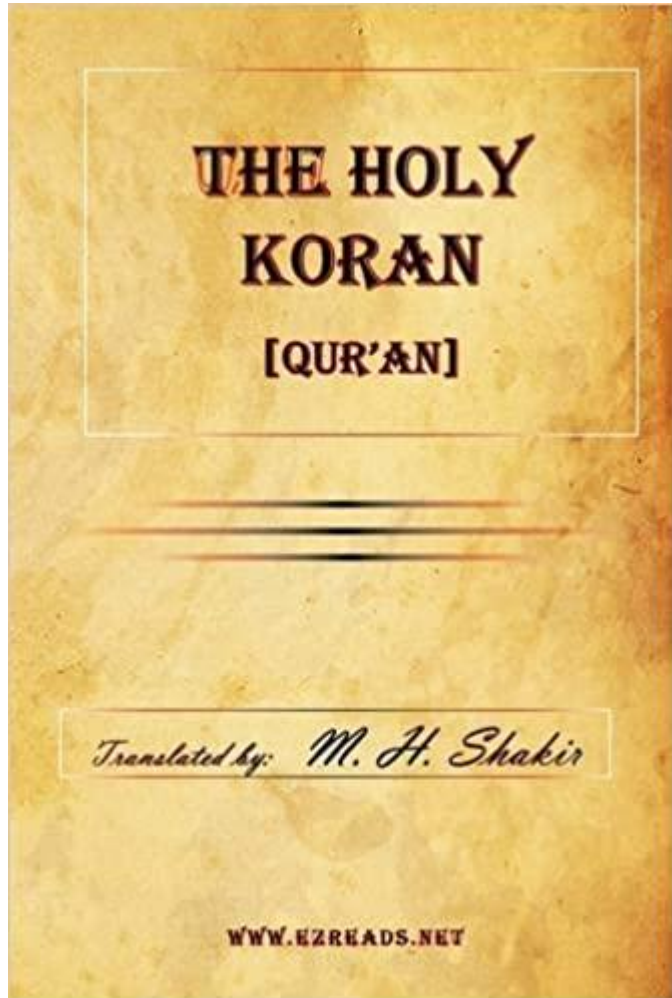

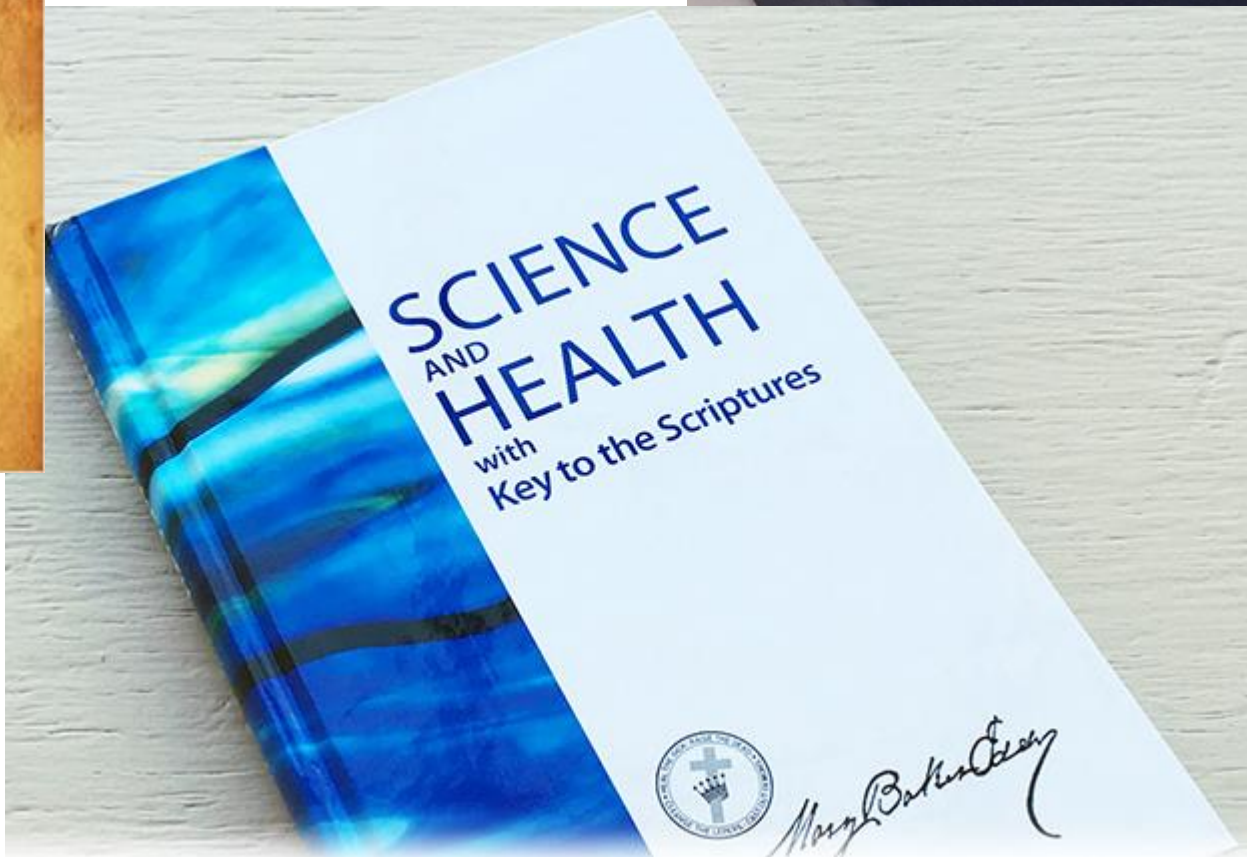

Yes, but it no longer exists. The books found in the New Testament were written by either Paul or his followers. The gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John have been proven by Biblical scholars not to be those of the disciples of Prophet Jesus but written by people who bore the same names and never met the prophet. The Book given to Prophet Jesus, together with the teachings of Prophet Jesus' disciples were destroyed by Constantine, the Emperor of Rome, at the Conference of Nicea because they preached the Oneness of the Creator who does not have a son.

During the Methodist Conference that has taken place this week, the Methodist Church in the UK approved by 254 votes in favour, and 46 against, a resolution that “consents in principle to the marriage of same-sex couples on Methodist premises by its ministers”.

Furthermore, the Conference **affirmed cohabitation**, recognising that “the love of God is present within the love of human beings who enter freely into some form of life-enhancing committed relationship, whether that be through informal cohabitation or a more formal commitment entered into publicly”.

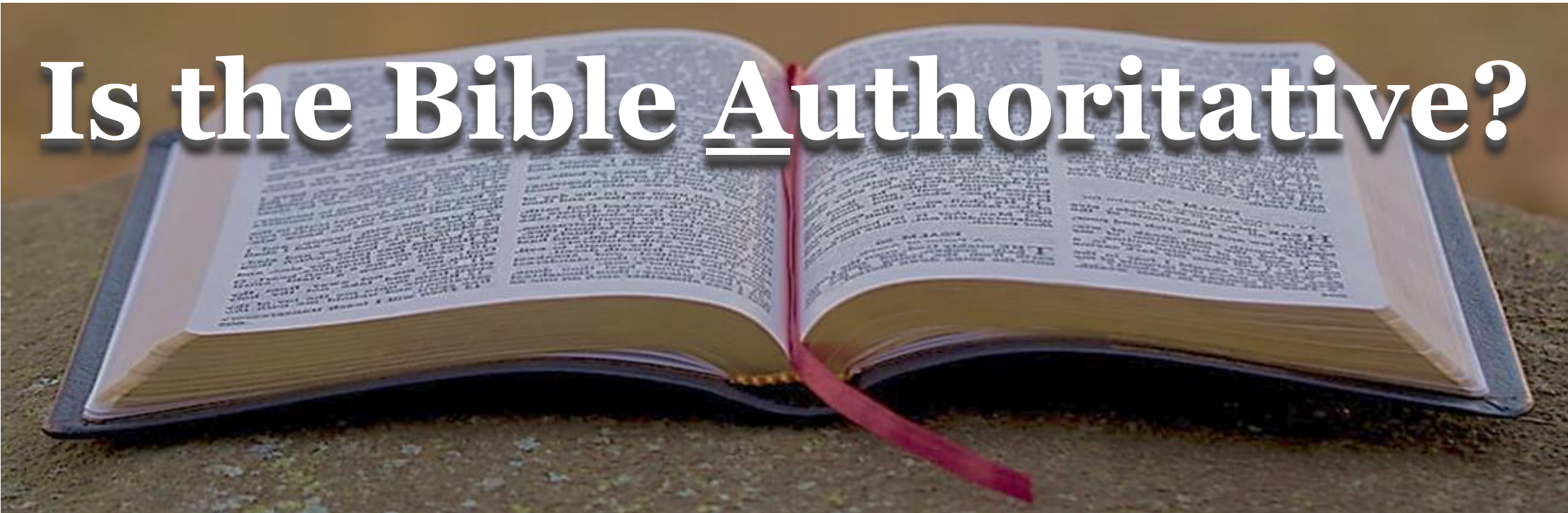

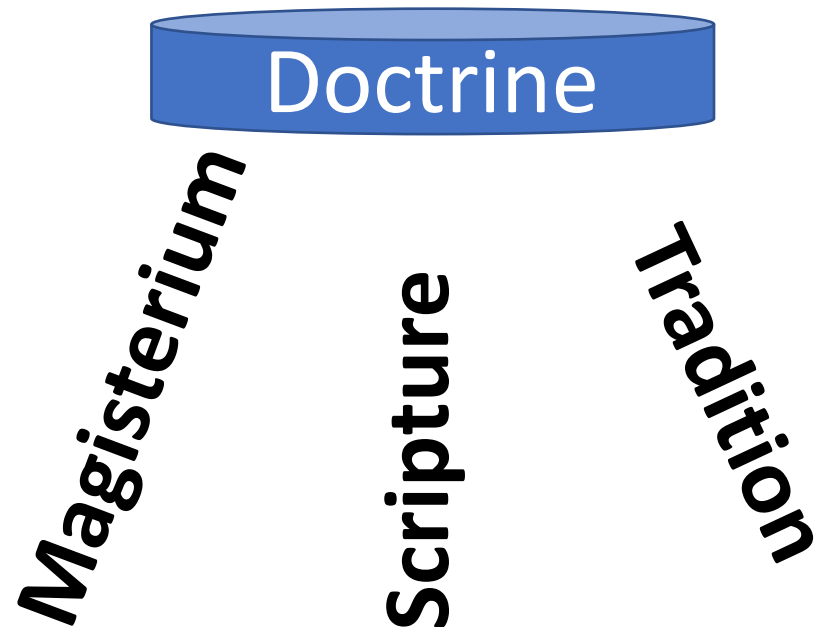
Cyril of Jerusalem (c 350AD): “Even to me, who tell you these things, do not give ready belief, unless you receive from the Holy Scriptures the proof of the things I announce.

The salvation in which we believe is proved not from clever reasoning, but from the Holy Scriptures.”

Augustine to Jerome (c 400AD): “If any error, even the smallest, be admitted in the Scripture, the whole authority of scripture is presently invalidated and destroyed.”

Death, Burial, Resurrection of Jesus Christ

Tradition:

According to Church tradition, Veronica was moved with sympathy seeing Jesus carrying the cross to Calvary and gave him her veil so that he could wipe his forehead. Jesus accepted the offer, and when he returned the veil the image of his face was miraculously captured on it. The resulting relic became known as the Veil of Veronica.

Jerome – Latin Vulgate ~400AD

John Wycliffe – 1328-1384

“No man is to be credited for his mere authority’s sake, unless he can show Scripture for the maintenance of his opinion.”

John Wycliffe – 1300's

“It is certain that the truth of the Christian faith becomes more evident the more the faith itself is known. Therefore, the doctrine should not only be in Latin but also in the common tongue, and as the faith of the Church is contained in the Scriptures, the more these are known in the true sense, the better.”

Translated Bible from Vulgate (Latin) into English

1428- excommunicated, remains exhumed, burned

Jan Hus – 1400's

People should obey the Church only
when the Church agrees with the Bible

Johannes Gutenberg – 1453
the printing press

A Bible in every hand?

William Tyndale – 1525

Translated NT from Greek into English & published (1st from printing press)
- burned at the stake 1536

Council of Trent – 1545

Indulgences, Latin, faith & works,
and our (HRCC) own Bible

King James Bible - 1611

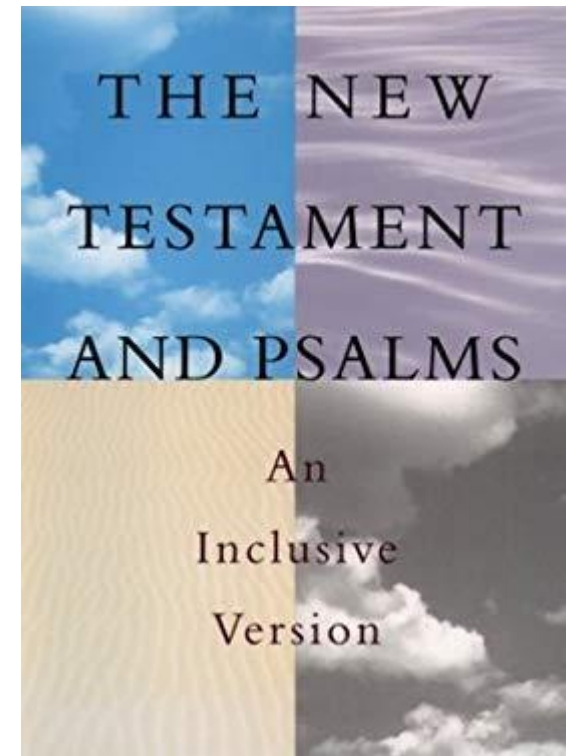

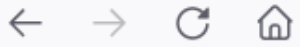
"Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with womankind:
